

The articles for name - a revolver, purse (empty) + some correspondence - were contained in the larger effects received. Those missing are:- field-glasses (engraved

name + address), knife (engraved  
name), compass, luminous wrist-  
cigar case, whistle, + pocket-book  
containing letters from home + etc.

I must include the loss of  
the smaller things with the (treasure)  
of all - my son. They are of little  
moment, - except the correspondence,  
the latest of which he could not have  
destroyed, which probably included  
his last written words to me.

every possible inquiry; I thank you.
