In the fifth place that my said Dispoñees shall pay the following legacies viz: To the Kirk Session of my native parish of Auchterquarn in the County of Perth for behoof of the poor of that parish £50 - To or for the benefit of the Infirmary established or now establishing in Perth £50 and to the Royal Infirmary of Glasgow the like sum of £50 payable to said legacies last mentioned and that to my niece Jean Thomas at the first term of Whits or Mart happening six months after my death; And in the last place I appoint my said Dispoñees to pay at the same term if not otherwise provided for any other legacies which I may hereafter leave and bequeath, if I so think proper, either to any person or persons or for charitable or other purposes by any Codicil under my hand bearing reference thereto; Moreover I do hereby Nominate and Appoint the said James Thomas John Thomas & Charles Thomas and their forewards respectively to be my sole executors and universal legatees and intromittors unto my means, estate, and effects excluding and

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debarring all others from that office - Reserving always my own inherent right use and possession of the whole subjects heritable and moveable generally and particularly before conveyed, and also full faculty liberty and power to alter or cancel those presents in whole or in part as I shall see cause at any time in my life, and even on deathbed, but declaring the same as not altered nor revoked by me to be a good valid and effectual Deed whether found lying by myself or in the custody of any other person undelivered at the time of my death I hereby dispense with the delivery thereof. And I consent to the Registration hereof in the Books of Council and Session (and Session) or others competent for pruuation and execution as effects and thereto constitute
