#### **FOREWORD**

It is not without some feeling of sadness that one looks back to an equaintanceship and association of over half a century with a collector, exercised and beloved, whom one has watched assiduously forming a magnificent collection of specialized series of coins, wisely selected for their reauty and rarity, and to be entrusted with the painful duty of compiling the catalogue of these treasures for sale by auction to be dispersed again all the world. Truly, the wise man in Ecclesiastes has well said "What profit hath a man in all his labour which he taketh under the sun?". The consolation seems to be that the hobby of collecting has procured andless enjoyment to the owner and has proved a beneficial relaxation in the arduous duties of his profession.

Henry Platt Hall was the eldest son of William Hall, M.R.C.S. of Salford. He was born on the 9th of April, 1863, and died on the 15th of December, 1949. He was educated at the Manchester Grammar School and abroad and joined the firm of Platt Bros. & Co., Ltd., Textile Machinery Makers of Oldham, as an apprentice in June, 1880.

After working through the shops, H. P. Hall was sent abroad to make known his firm's products in many European countries, including Russia. Subsequently following various administrative appointments in the Oldham works he was made an Employee Director in 1897, a full Director in 1902, Vice-Chairman in 1912 and Chairman in 1920. In July, 1924, he retired in order to live a less active life in the country.

In the course of his business career, H. P. H. held many appointments. He was a Member of the Institute of Mechanical Engineers, also of the Institute of British Foundrymen, a Trustee and Member of the Management Committee of the Engineering and Allied Employers Federation, etc. He was an expert metal worker in almost every branch of the trade, including moulding, fitting, turning, planning, slotting, boring, etc. Building also had a great fascination for him.

Apart from his business career H. P. H. had many other interests of which shooting and fishing took an important place. Gunpowder always had an attraction to him from childhood to old age; as a boy he used to make his own fireworks and in later years derived much pleasure by blowing up logs for firewood. He was a good shot with rifle, pistol and shotgun. At high pheasants and ducks he excelled and within a few weeks of his death got a spectacular right and left at high driven duck. He was a keen fisherman in every branch of the sport.

Numismatics, which interests our readers most, took a most important part in his numerous activities, occupied a great deal of his time and provided a never failing source of enjoyment, especially in latter years when his outdoor pursuits were necessarily restricted. Every Coin Sale, whether in this country or abroad, which touched on his own particular series was of especial interest, but apart from such events he always seemed able to spend happy hours with a tray of coins and reference books from his large numismatic and historical library. His interest in coins probably started in the seventies of last century. When a school boy at the Manchester Grammar School he used to buy coins from a nearby dealer, though having regard to a schoolboy's finances—especially at that time—the coins could not have been of much value. From 1895-1949 there is a complete record with receipts for every coin purchased.

H. P. Hall was an ardent collector for over sixty years, and having the means of gratifying his taste he rarely missed securing a piece he desired to possess. His principal interest was Roman coins. His collection of bronze coins is famous, and the gold series comprises some 400 coins, including great rarities as Didius Julianus, Manlia Scantilla, Albinus, Septimius Severus and family, Caracalla and Plautilla, Diadumenianus, Postumus,

Victorinus, Tetricus, Marius, Carausius, Allectus, Galeria Valeria, Procopius, Priscus Attalus, Licinia Eudoxia, Glycerius, and some exceptionally good Byzantine coins.

In the Greek series, which are included in the present catalogue, lots 1-369, he specialized in portrait pieces.

A very good representative collection of English coins will be sold, as Part III, at about the same time as Part I; Part II comprising the remainder of the Roman coins will be sold some time in the Autumn.

Mr. H. P. Hall was for a number of years on the Council of the Royal Numismatic Society and he took a scientific interest in the coins he collected. He had a fine perception of what was good and was a keen judge of genuineness.

This is hardly the place to characterise the personal qualities which endeared him to those who had the good fortune to know him. Free from self-assertion he was a good friend of collectors and coin-dealers alike.

So far as public activities are concerned, H. P. H. served as High Sheriff of Montgomeryshire 1923-29 and was made a J.P. for the County of Montgomery in November, 1932. He was also a Member of the Severn Fishery Board from 1928-1945.

The collection which is now being offered for sale ranks amongst the best formed since the Sir Arthur Evans Cabinets.
