Lieut. Bell died on the 28rd February last of wounds received the previous day. I enclose the official telegram which Mrs. Bell received from the War Office as I understand you require to see this. I may mention that Lieut. Bell was Mrs. Bell's only child and that he left no other near relation, and that Messrs. Cox & Co. have paid over to her the amount standing to her son's credit without requiring her to take out letters of Administration.
