East Kent Regiment commonly called "The Buffs" being a Soldier in actual Military Service Declare this to be my last Will and I DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all my real and personal property of every description to my brother Harold Arthur Barham and I APPOINT my Father Arthur Saxby Barham to be the Sole EXECUTOR of this my Will PROVIDED ALWAYS that if the said Arthur Saxby Barham shall be unable or unwilling to act THEN I APPOINT my uncle George Titus Barham EXECUTOR hereof in his stead IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this twelfth day of August 1914.


