Work on C 6 progressing slowly. Snow obscured by clouds + slight drizzle but fairly light to work. Inverted A Frame + corrugated iron required as advanced dump. working parties Northants-	
"	18.1.16		working parties Northants- 230. The party from the rear billets did not arrive so that the work of No 3 Section was somewhat hampered. No 2 Section revetted FISH ST with frame + corr^d iron; but it still requires sand-bagging on each side. Very light night; snipers active especially in front of STABLES. O.C. went over trench with C.R.E. G.O.C. 73 Brigade visited trench.

YPRES	19.1.16		Regret following Casualties Lieut J.B. WHITFIELD, Sapper — HAZELL, & Pioneer SULLIVAN. He The two men died from their wounds the same evening. LT WHITFIELD was taken to MENIN Road Dressing Station & sent on immediately by motor ambulance to VLAAMBERTINGHE & then to No 10 Casualty Clearing Station near POPERINGHE. Very bright night, enemy, troops and bombers very active.	
"	20		LT J.B. WHITFIELD died of his wounds at 5.30 am. Infantry working parties. Lenses 270. Machine 100. Clear night.
