1 Mel09 demaged (Camera gun fired st each burst).

W/O. Cunninghem states "I was flying Yellow 2 in a formation of 6 e/c. on an Armed Recoe. to Osnabruok-Gutersloh area. We were warned by 182 Squadron that MelO9s were attacking them. At this time both 137 and 182 Squadrons were over the Dulmen area. I saw a MelO9 at 2 o'clock, range 400 yards about 2,000 ft. above coming straight in. The E/A. passed close behind Yellow 1 who was flying dead ahead 100 yards. E/A. then broke yo starboard down exposing his belly. I tunned slightly starboard down and followed - firing one 1sec. burst. No results were observed. Range 100 yards 30° deflection. E/A. continued diving turn on to his back and I fired one 2-sec. burst range 200 yards, no deflection. I saw strikes between the wing radiators and I saw an explosion and grey smoke poiring from him. E/A. dived into cloud upside down and disappeared. I claim one MelO9 damaged."
