	16	Int.	Heavy shelling started 1900hrs. Enemy Wk. advanced 1930 Ls. headed by 44 and 20 Iks respectively. March Co. not engaged. 18 enemy tanks were knocked out, and the remainder withdrew.	
	17-21		Remained in same area. A Co. relieved 'C' Co. in July 16. 'C' Co. going to Rear Brigade. Evening of 21: March Co. moved up and relieved July Co. at first light on 22 nd in area 876264.	
	22-30 th		March Co. remained in same area, withdrawing 3 miles down to Laguna early night. The enemy was holding the Battara Box - Gabel K. A. M. East of Khadim, - the Targa Plateau, and patrolled
